

PHOTOGRAPHS (GLASS) COLLECTION

Box 1: Glass plates, filed as follows:

20-25 College buildings
26-39 Groups and individuals
40-43 Campus scenes
44-47 Machines and tools
48-49 Colorado scenes
50-68 Farm machinery*

Row 2:

69-112 Farm machinery

* All the farm machinery slides appear to be a commercial presentation.

Box 2: Glass plates:

Box 3: Glass plates. Campus scenes and activities in envelopes numbered 2-205. Some are broken, many are missing. Small box with two glass negatives and two prints.

PHG-2:

Box 1: Glass slides in envelopes numbered 2-91. General agricultural subjects. Most missing.

Glass slides in envelopes numbered 134-271. (A different series from above.) Many missing. Labelled "Animal Husbandry." Group of loose glass slides and several photographic prints. No numbers, not identified.

Archival envelope: Several negatives for pictures believed to be in PHO collection, possibly from Ruth J. Wattles.

PHG-3:

This group of glass slides appears to be commercially bought souvenirs of someone's trip or trips abroad. There are 18 slides of the Methodist Episcopal church in China, 10 slides of Greece, 19 of miscellaneous European and English sights, and an almost complete slide presentation on the English lake country consisting originally of 50 slides. Their relevance to the Colorado State University Archives is questionable.
